

**Children's and Youth Chorus of Greater Dallas**  
**CODE OF CONDUCT/ETHICS**

*Please be aware of the great responsibility of transporting and supervising a large number of singers. In order to see to your safety and conduct, it may become necessary at times to sacrifice individual interests and desires for the welfare of the choir.*

**Listed below are the rules of behavior that MUST be adhered to.** There are no warnings to be given. This list IS your warning.

1. Singers will be expected to follow directions given by any director or chaperone. The activities will follow the itinerary. No singer shall change the itinerary schedule.
2. DO NOT leave the hotel without the permission of your chaperone.
3. At no time or place should you be in a group of fewer than three or four singers. This is for your protection.
4. Singers are expected to observe the designated time lines and curfews. (Curfew is defined as being in your OWN assigned room by the designated hour). Singers continually late will be sequestered from the other singers during the course of the trip.
5. No girls will be allowed in boys' rooms. No boys will be allowed in girls' rooms. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. If a singer is responsible for stealing or vandalism, the singer and his/her parents will be expected to pay any and all damages. Shoplifting will be dealt with by the local police department.
7. Singers/participants attending any CCGD/YCGD trip/performance/activity may not purchase, possess, consume, or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any time. Violators will be subject to stringent disciplinary action, as well as possible police intervention. If there is a violation, parents will be expected to escort their child home at their own expense. Other disciplinary actions will follow.
8. Smoking or using tobacco products or being in possession of such at a CCGD/YCGD activity is prohibited.
9. Singers are to dress appropriately throughout the course of the trip. If you have to ask, don't wear it. No spaghetti straps, exposed midriffs, tattoos, body piercing, body alterations, etc.
10. Any charges to the hotel room will be the responsibility of the individual singer and/or their parents. Phone calls made on the pay phones in the lobby must be made BEFORE curfew.  
*Important Note: Long Distance phone service in the hotel rooms will not be accessible.*
11. Any damage to the hotel will be the responsibility of the singer and/or parent. Upon arrival, check for any existing damage. Singers who disregard the rules will be subject to disciplinary action and will be sent home at the expense of the individual singer and his/her parents. Parents will be notified immediately if such action occurs.

I have read the Code of Conduct/ Ethics for CCGD/YCGD and agree to abide by all rules and expectations. Failure to comply with the above rules will result in my immediate return to Dallas by plane at my parent's expense.
