

RTC PROGRAM

Questions and Answers

1. **What part of tuition does RTC cover?** All singers must pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit. RTC will be used to cover as much of the remaining tuition as the singer earns (e.g. 2 singers = \$100 discount).
2. **Are brothers and sisters counted as new members?** No, siblings already receive a discount.
3. **What if a family applies for tuition assistance – how will RTC be used?** Again, all singers pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit. RTC will be used to cover the next portion of tuition. The remaining portion will be fully covered by tuition assistance (if “full” assistance is awarded), partially covered (if “partial” assistance is awarded), or paid by the family (if assistance is denied).
4. **So, does that mean that if we are not sure whether tuition assistance will be awarded, RTC would be a good way to reduce our tuition costs?** Yes
5. **Is there any limit to RTC credits?** No, if you have more credit than your tuition costs, we will assign your extra credit to your tour account. Note that you would need between 5 and 10 new members to join to fully cover your tuition.
6. **How will you account for the credits?** We will reduce your tuition due by your number of new singers who have made their \$50 deposits. However, experience has shown that a few of these new singers will not join CCGD. If any of your new singers do not join, you will lose the \$50 credit and will be billed for that amount in September.

An example: Your child is in Apprentice and has 4 singers who have submitted a \$50 deposit. You have already paid your deposit so your August tuition bill would be \$300 - \$200 = \$100. However, if one of your new singers, despite paying the \$50 deposit, decides not to join CCGD, you would lose that credit and would be billed \$50 in September.

7. **How will CCGD know that we are due a tuition credit?** Tell the prospect to list your name on the questionnaire that is filled out at the audition.
8. **What if the new singer lists more than one recruiting family?** The \$50 tuition credit will be shared among the recruiting families listed.
