- Call: Concert II 5:00 PM PLEASE BE PROMPT. Meet in the lobby on the left side. See map on back.
Parking: There are multiple parking options in the Arts District. Go to the Meyerson website, https://www.mydso.com/plan-your-visit/directions-and-parking for more information. Allow plenty of time for Dallas traffic.
Drop Off: Front door of the Meyerson - Find your chorus in the lobby on the left.
Wear: Full concert attire - This will be your concert attire check! Black mask that you received at rehearsal.
Bring: As little as possible - NO FOOD OR DRINK!
Concert: 7:30 PM
Pick Up: 8:30 PM - in the lobby - as you exit down the white steps, Con II will be to the right. There is no carpool pick-up for Con II.
Tickets: All tickets for this concert will be sold online at our website (www.thechildrenschorus.org) or at the door, if available. To avoid long lines, please purchase your tickets in advance and use the print-at-home option. * Concert Attire for this concert:

Girls: Black and white concert dress hemmed 1" from the floor, black opaque tights, black leather ballet slippers. Hair must be clean and secured away from face and shoulders with discrete black or invisible clips. If hair is longer than shoulder length, it must be secured with a ponytail.

NO make-up, nail polish, jewelry, perfume - NO EXCEPTIONS

NO sports bras - they cross in the back and can be seen from the stage

Boys: Tuxedo shirt (wing-tip collar with white buttons), tuxedo pants (the hem of the pants should be just resting on the top of the shoe with a small break in the front and falling just above the heel in the back)

Black tie and black cummerbund;

Black crew socks; Black dress shoes - NO athletic shoes or cowboy boots

NO jewelry, makeup or cologne.

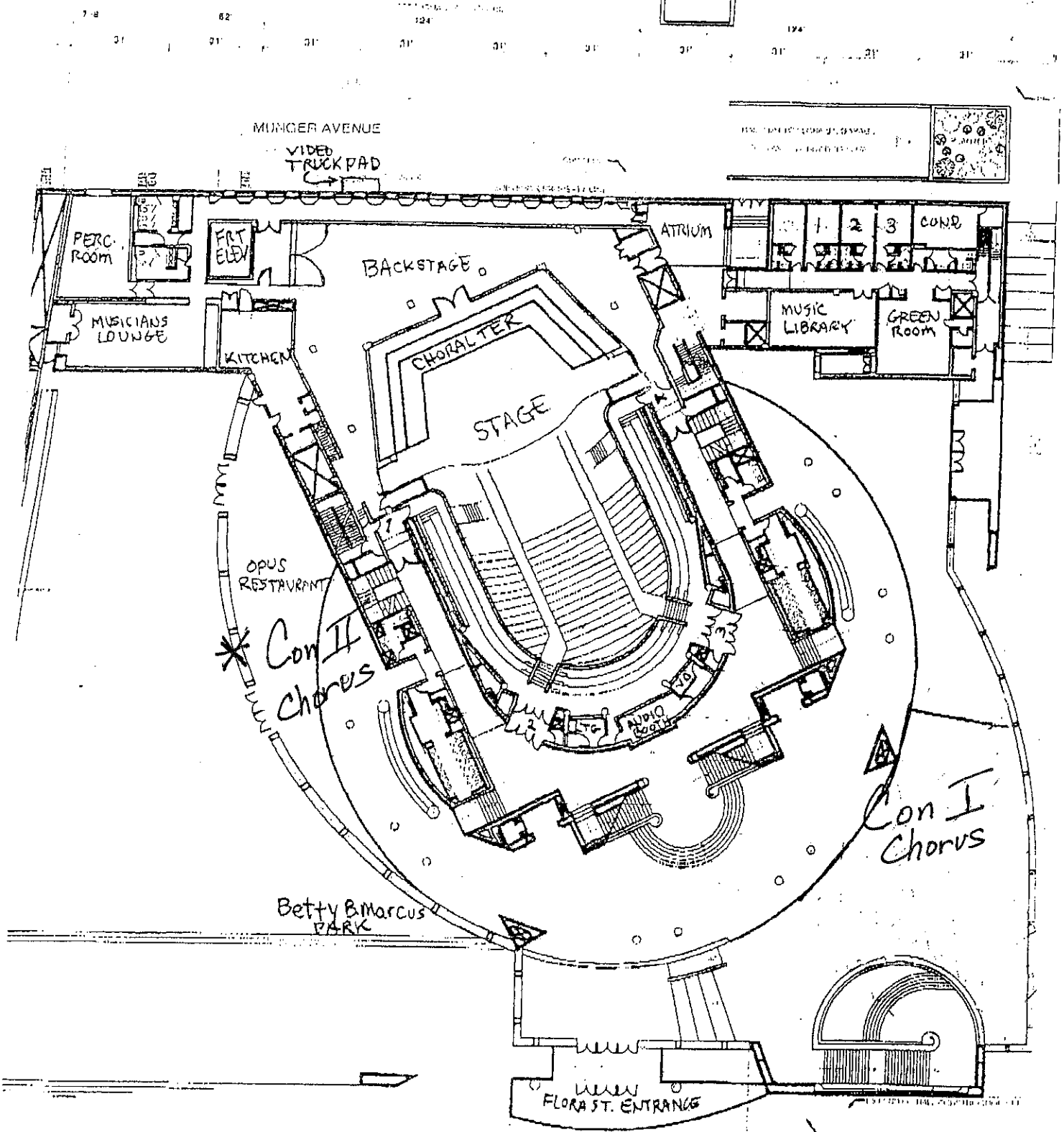
Hair must be clean and secured away from face and shoulders with black or invisible clips; if long, hair must be secured in a ponytail.
